## VOLUNTEER SERVICE DESCRIPTION

Under the general supervision of the Director of Auxiliary and Volunteer Services and collaborating with the Obstetrics department, volunteer will hold infants needing more support. The volunteer will be educated on how to keep a baby swaddled. Volunteer will be trained on how to perform a two minute hand scrub. Volunteer will be educated on the importance of a pacifier and how to decrease environmental stimulation of infants. Volunteer will be required to have 2 hours of job shadowing with a mother/baby nurse.
